Per my conversation with Assemblymember Levine's office at 1:25pm pst today, California Assembly Bill 1634 'is set for hearing on the 25th.' While AB1634 still is not listed on the Senate Daily File officially, I have spoken with the Senate Local Government Committee and they have confirmed that the bill is set to be heard on 25 June.

I have also learned that it is essential that all individuals and organizations & clubs 're-submit' their letters of opposition to the Senate Local Government Committee and the Senators of the Committee so that your opposition will be included in the bill's analysis.

The staff of the Senate Local Government advises that you include the Assembly bill number and your position at the top of your email and/or fax. Please also include your name and address. You can keep these letters simple.

I OPPOSE AB1634

It is very important that you get your emails and faxes sent to all members of the Committee in addition to Peter Detwiler, Staff Director for Senate Local Government Committee, immediately!! The amendments should be available in print tomorrow ... however ... the analyses will be done late Thursday/early Friday.

Peter Detwiler will be compiling the list of support and opposition. PLEASE FAX YOUR OPPOSITION TO HIS ATTENTION TODAY!!
